BABY DOG A lovely class of babies!.

No. 8 Standndeliva Heres Johnny.
Lovely balanced baby with a good head with dark eyes and kindly expression.
Nice front and rear angles, moved out well.

No 1. Giltedge Repeat Performance.
Another lovely baby with a good head , good angles front and rear, level topline.
Just rolling on the move today.

No 3. Goldbrior Be It In Fine Style.
A cream boy with a pleasing head, dark eye and good angles in front with good turn of stifle.
Moved well.

MINOR DOG

No 11. Alnclair Magnus at Ramgold.
Nicely put together, correct head with dark eye and lovely expression .
Good angulation front and rear with level topline and tail set.
Slightly turning out of toes. Good bone. Moved out well.

No 9. Eurogold Hard Evidence.
Lovely head and expression with dark pigment. Level topline and Strong bone.
A little longer cast than no 1. I would like a bit more upper arm. Good hindquarters.

No 10. Montego Ima Majik Dutch Boy (ai)
Balanced young boy with pleasing head and good pigment. Would like a bit more upper arm. Didn't move well today and a little close behind.

PUPPY DOG.

No 14. Fantango Playing the Game (ai)
Well balanced with good width in front, neck flows into well laid shoulders.
Good angles in upper arm. Good head with dark eye and pigment.
Strong bone, level topline and tail set. Good turn of stifle. Moved with drive.

No 13. Moondust Glenlivit (imp mdl)
Balanced cream boy with pleasing head. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders and upper arm. Nice turn of stifle. Not moving smoothly in rear today.

No 16. Aubairn Possofoeper.
Nice head, eye could be darker. Good reach of neck. Good angles fore and aft.
Moved out well.

JUNIOR DOG

No 17. Alnclair St. Martin In The Field.

Well balanced with good front and rear angulation. Correct head and expression with dark eye and dark pigment. Level topline and tailset. Short coupled. Once he settled on the move he showed correct movement.

No 19. Goldkey Incan Idol.

Strong head with good stop. Good flow from neck into shoulders with good upper arm angles Short coupled. Moved out well but just dropped his tail down now and again on the move.

No 18. Goldtreve Wild Murphy Magic

Nice cream boy with kindly expression. Good angles front and rear. Moved well.

INTERMEDIATE DOG

No 22. Ch. Goldew Southern Son.

Liked this boy with his beautiful gold coat in great condition. Good head and expression. Good overall balance with flow from neck into well laid shoulders, and good upper arm. Level topline and tailset. A touch longer in the loin. Powerful hind quarters which he used strongly moving around the ring.

No 25. Heatwave Spirit of Northern Light.(Imp Swd)

Cream boy with pretty coat. Would prefer a slightly stronger head with a bit more stop, nice dark eye. Good reach of neck into shoulders. Good topline, carried his tail higher on the move. Strong moving dog.

No 28. Bluebreeze The Flying Scotsman.

Balanced gold boy who moved around the ring well when he settled. Good head with gentle expression. Nice flow into shoulders from neck. Good hindquarters.

AUST BRED DOG

No 38. Ch. Burragundy Brace Yourself ET.

Liked this boy as he came into the ring with great presence. Balanced head and good expression. Excellent neck flowing into well laid shoulders and good upperarm. Good forechest. Level topline and tailset. Good strong bone. Powerful hindquarters with good let down of hock. Short coupled. Strong firm muscles. Shown in top condition. Moved with reach and drive from his powerful hindquarters.

I was pleased to award this dog, Challenge dog and Best in Show.

No 33. Ch. Larbellah Team Leader.

Another well put together balanced dog with good head and expression, and good pigment. Strong level topline and tailset. Strong powerful hindquarters which he showed on the move. Lovely gold coat in top condition.

No 36. Ch. Giltedge Follow The Leader.

Another well balanced dog with pleasing head. Good forechest. A little shorter in upper arm. Strong hindquarters. Moved well.

OPEN DOG

No 43. Ch. Burragundy Dusty Drover.

Lovely head with melting expression. Dark eye and pigment. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, good angulation in front. Level topline and tailset. Strong hindquarters. Loved his beautiful movement. Just floated along with such ease showing reach and drive. I was pleased to award this boy Reserve Challenge.

No 41. Ch. Larbellah Take The Lead.

Another lovely strong dog with pleasing head. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, with good forechest. Level topline and tailset. Strong hindquarters used well on the move.

No 45. Gr. Ch. Fantango Wild Oats.

Correct head with good stop, dark eye and kindly expression. Well balanced with clean outline with good reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Good angles in front and strong hindquarters. Slightly sore in shoulder today which spoilt his movement.

VETERAN DOG

No 49. C. Alnclair Gillys Hero.

Loved this boy's classic head, so balanced with dark eye and pigment. Lovely expression. Excellent front angulations and strong rear. Good forechest. Level topline and tailset. Moved with style and drive.

BABY BITCH

No 58. Giltedge Cheer Me On

Well balanced with good flow from neck into shoulders. Good angulation in front and rear. Feminine head with dark eye and good pigment. Level topline and tailset. Moved out well.

No 57. Burragundy Real Surreal.

Very pretty correct head with lovely dark eye and good expression. Good front and rear angles. A balanced baby who moved out very well.

No 50. Giltedge Catch My Drift.

Well balanced baby with good angles in front and rear. Level topline and tailset, moved out well.

MINOR BITCH

No 69. Aubairn in Rapsches.

A very feminine bitch with a pleasing head and expression. Good flow into shoulders and good upper arm. Good bone. Nice turn of stifle. Her movement was flowing with reach and drive.

No 68. Philini Gloria Victis

Balanced bitch with good angulation front and rear. Good reach of neck. Sweet head, lovely eye and expression. Moved well.

No 66. Fernfall Wild Flower.

Another lovely bitch with pleasing head and kindly expression. Good flow from neck into shoulders, would like more upper arm. Good topline and bone. Moved out well.

PUPPY BITCH

No 73. Fetchnpoint Catch of the Day.

A very alert gold bitch with pleasing head. Great attitude. Good angulation in front and rear. Level topline. Moved out well.

No 71. Fantango Truly Madly Deeply (ai)

Liked this lovely cream bitch with a very feminine head. Had the front and upperarm, lovely flow from neck into shoulders. Level topline and tailset. Good turn of stifle and good let down of hock. A pity she wouldn't move properly today.

No 71. Japorik Miss Rosebay.

Another cream bitch with pleasing head and expression. Good flow into shoulders from neck. Longer in coupling. Good topline and tailset. Moved well.

JUNIOR BITCH

No 77. Fetchnpoint You and Whose Army (ai)

Stylish cream bitch with excellent flow from neck into shoulders and good angulation in upperarm with level topline and good tail set, short coupled. Strong hindquarters. Pleasing head, good pigment and dark eye. Moved beautifully with style.

No 75. Heatwave Leap of Faith (Imp Swd)

Balanced cream bitch with clean outline. Good flow into shoulders, would like a little more upperarm angle, level topline, good turn of stifle. Moved out well.

No 76. Philini Watch Out For Tegan.

Another nice gold bitch with good flow into shoulders and good upperarm. Nice turn of stifles. Moved out well.

INTERMEDIATE BITCH

No 84. Giltedge Soul Sister.

Pleasing feminine head with lovely expression, dark eye. Good reach of neck into shoulders with good angulation of upper arm. Level topline and tailset. Strong hindquarters. Powerful mover.

No 86. Ch. Alnclair Lily of the Valley.

Balanced cream bitch with correct feminine head, dark eye and pigment. Good angles and turn of stifle. Moved strongly around the ring.

No 87. Alnclair Poppy in the Field.

Gold girl nicely put together with good angulations in front and rear. Moved strongly with drive.

AUST BRED BITCH

No 98. Ch. Yellowfetch Shinin Light.

Very stylish well balanced cream bitch with good front angulation and strong hindquarters. Level topline and good tailset. Lovely head and expression with dark pigment. Liked this bitch as she powerfully moved around the ring with reach and drive. I was pleased to award her Reserve Challenge.

No 99. Ch. Dykinta Devine Right.

Balanced gold bitch, good head. Good reach of neck into shoulders with angles in front and good turn of stifle. Strong hindquarters, moved with drive.

No 96. Ch. Fantango Playing the Field.

Cream scopey bitch with good angles in front and rear. Level topline. Pleasing head. Moved out well.

OPEN BITCH

No 103. Ch. Eurogold Eye Catcher.

Correct feminine classic head with lovely melting expression, dark eye and pigment. Well balanced with reach of neck flowing into well laid shoulders with good upperarm. Level topline. Good turn of stifle. Shown in good coat. Moved out with plenty of drive. I was pleased to award her Challenge Bitch and Runnerup In Show.

No 104. Ch. Giltedge Sister Act.

A very nice bitch with pleasing head. Good flow into well laid shoulders, good forechest. Strong hindquarters. Moved out with drive.

No 102. Ch. Montego Bridget Jones.

Pleasing head and expression. Good reach of neck into shoulders. Good angulation in front and rear. Level topline. Moved out well.

VETERAN BITCH

No 108. Ch. Alnclair Aiming High.

Feminine head with kindly dark eye and expression. Flow into shoulders and upperarm correct. Level topline. Short coupled. Moved out with reach and drive.

No 107. Ch. Montego As You Wish.

Nicely balanced gold bitch with well laid shoulders and good upper arm. Short coupled. Level topline. Strong hindquarters.

No 111. Sup. Ch. Yellowfetch Whatzit To U ET.

Strong gold bitch with good reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Good forechest. Level topline and tailset. Moved with drive.

NEUTER DOG

No 112. Ch. Alnclair Sir Barnabus.

Gold boy with a lovely coat. Head a bit strong for me. Good angulations in front and rear. Level topline. Moved with drive.

No 114. Caerhays Glen Hamish RN.

Smaller cream dog. A bit short in upperarm. Nice turn of stifle. Good topline.
Moved around ring nicely.

NEUTER BITCH

No 115. Montego Field of Dreams CD.

Cream bitch with correct head with dark eye and pigment. Good reach of neck into shoulders, a little short in upperarm. Good topline and tailset. Turns feet out a little in front. Moved out well.

No 117. Goldkey Dream Weaver.

Cream bitch with good reach of neck into shoulders. Needs more upper arm. Good topline and tailset. Moved well.

No 116. Ramgold Regal Rumber.

Nice cream bitch. Shorter in upperarm. Level topline and good turn of stifle. Moved well.
